Pawnee Indian Museum near Republic is providing an opportunity for teachers to offer students a unique educational experience!

This field trip is designed to meet specific Kansas history, geography, reading, mathematics (geometry), and science (inquiry) indicators. This one-hour tour will take place in the museum and on the nature trail. This tour introduces first grade students to traditional homes of four Kansas Indian tribes: Pawnee, Kansa, Wichita, and Cheyenne. Your students will learn how the availability of natural resources influenced these tribes in the choice of style and materials used to make their homes.

This tour offers pre- and post-visit materials to help teachers provide students with supplemental learning.
